






Here's a hundred bucks


Serious coin

Believe it or not, this next little pile is \$1 million dollars (100 packets of \$10,000). You could stuff that into a grocery bag and walk around with it.




hat's what I'm talkin' about!

While a measly \$1 million looked a little unimpressive, \$100 million is a little more respectable. It fits neatly on a standard pallet...




Holy cow!

I give you \$1 Trillion dollars...




And notice those pallets are double stacked \$100 dollar bills!

(x-axis: total liquids production; y-axis: avg Brent-equivalent breakeven price*, \$/bbl)





Per Harvested Acre (2014 \$'s)




Where Have We Been: WI All-Milk Price





Is \$0.24 A Big Deal?


- \$0.24 X 24,000 cwt = \$57.60 /cow/ year
- \$57.60 X 25 cows = \$ 1,440
- \$57.60 X 50 cows = \$ 2,880
- \$57.60 X 100 cows = \$ 5,760
- \$57.60 X 500 cows = \$ 28,800
- \$57.60 X 1,000 cows = \$ 57,600























"You Can't Break the Rules"

- 2:1 Liquidity
- 20% of Milk check to pay P&I
- 85% Expense Rate
- \$3K-\$5K Debt/Cow (\$20/cwt)
- +30% Equity
- 3 Year Asset Turnover Rate
- 8% ROA (Profit)
- Know Your COP
